Welcome to Budapest – Host City for The 20th International Conference on Computer Science & Education (Budapest, Hungary July 21-25, 2026)

Budapest, Hungary's vibrant capital, provides an inspiring setting for the 20th International Conference on Computer Science and Education (IEEE ICCSE 2026). Getting to Budapest From the Airport to the City Center:

Budapest is served by Liszt Ferenc International Airport (BUD), which is located about 16 km (10 miles) southeast of the city center. There are several ways to get from the airport to downtown Budapest:

1. Public Transport:

- o The 100E Airport Shuttle Bus is a direct connection from the airport to the city center, running every 30 minutes. The ticket costs about 2000 HUF (approximately 5 EUR), and the trip takes around 40-45 minutes.
- o Alternatively, you can take Bus 200E to the nearest metro station (Kőbánya Kispest), then transfer to Metro Line 3 (blue line) for a fast connection to central locations.

2. Taxi:

Taxis are available at the designated taxi stands outside the airport terminal. A ride to the city center typically costs between 12,000-15,000 HUF (approx. 30-35 EUR) and takes about 30-40 minutes, depending on traffic.



3. Private Shuttle/Hotel Transfers:

Many hotels offer private airport shuttle services, and these can be arranged in advance. Check with your hotel for availability and pricing: <https://www.budapest.intercontinental.com/en/home>

Public Transport

Participants arriving at Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport can conveniently reach the ICCSE 2026 venue at Óbuda University (H-1034 Budapest, Bécsi út 96/B) using Budapest's efficient public transportation network.

Route 1 – Airport Bus + Metro + Tram (Recommended)

Take the 100E Airport Express bus from the airport to Deák Ferenc tér, the city's main transportation hub. From there, take Metro Line M2 to Batthyány tér and transfer to Tram 17, which stops near Obuda University. This route provides a fast and comfortable connection from the airport to the conference venue.

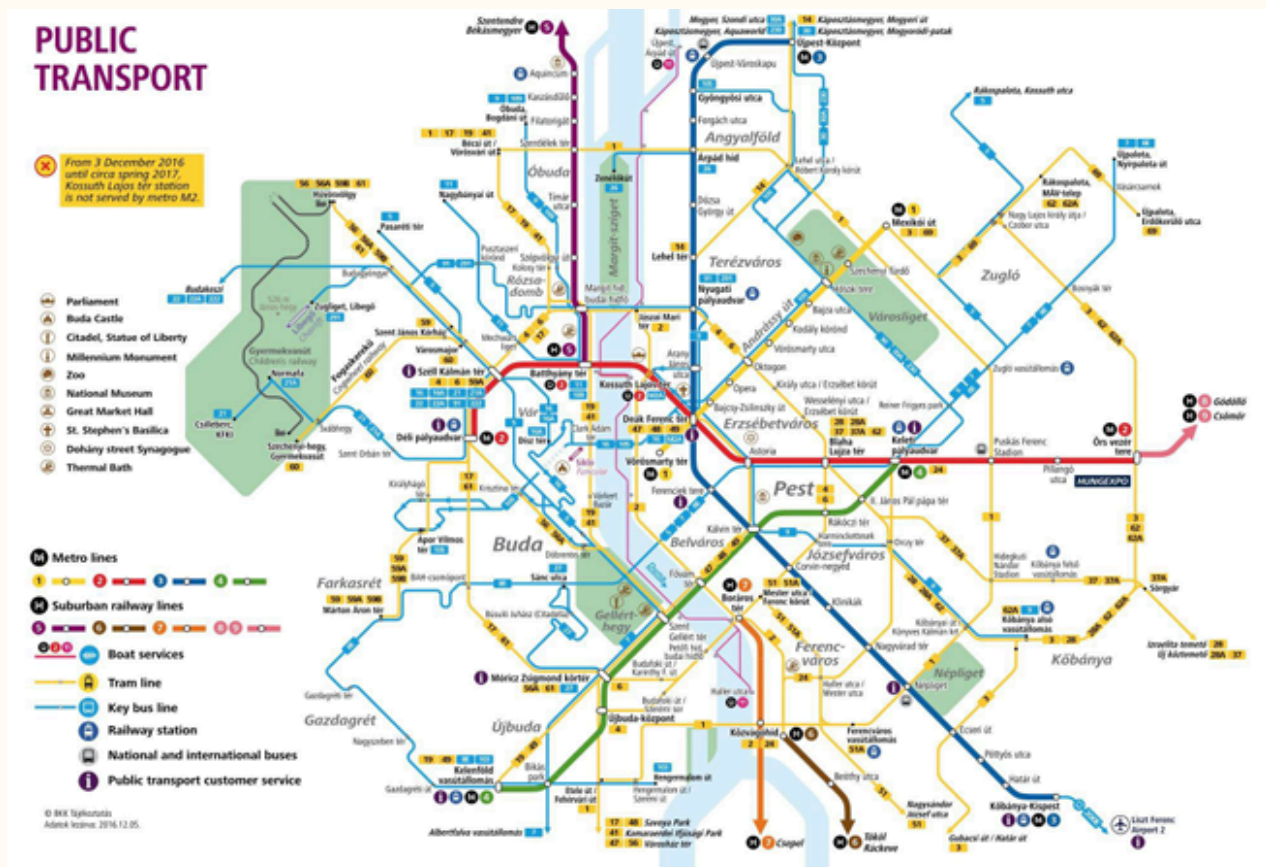
Route 2 – Airport Bus + Metro + Suburban Railway (HÉV)

Take the 100E Airport Express bus to Deák Ferenc tér, then travel by Metro Line M2 to Batthyány tér. From Batthyány tér, take the H5 suburban railway (HÉV) towards Szentendre and continue to the relevant Óbuda stop. The university can then be reached by a short walk or local bus connection.

Route 3 – Airport Bus 200E + Metro

As a budget-friendly alternative, take bus 200E from the airport to Kőbánya-Kispest, then continue by Metro Line M3 toward the city center. Depending on your accommodation location, transfer to Metro Line M2, trams, or buses serving the Óbuda district and Bécsi út area.

Budapest offers an integrated public transportation system including metro lines, trams, buses, and suburban railway services, making it easy for conference participants to travel between the airport, hotels, the city center, and the conference venue.

Walking to Key Attractions:

Weather in July

July is one of the warmest and sunniest months in Budapest, offering ideal conditions for exploring the city and participating in conference activities. Daytime temperatures typically range between 25°C and 30°C (77°F to 86°F), although occasional heat waves may bring temperatures above 35°C (95°F). Evenings are generally pleasant, with temperatures cooling to around 16°C–20°C (61°F–68°F).

Visitors can expect long daylight hours, abundant sunshine, and generally dry weather, though brief summer thunderstorms may occasionally occur. Lightweight clothing is recommended during the day, along with comfortable walking shoes, sunglasses, and sunscreen. Participants may also wish to bring a light jacket or sweater for air-conditioned conference rooms and cooler evening walks along the Danube River.

Overall, July provides excellent weather for enjoying Budapest's historic landmarks, vibrant cultural scene, outdoor cafés, and scenic riverfront attractions before and after conference sessions.

What to Pack:

- A light jacket or sweater for cooler evenings.
- Comfortable walking shoes, as Budapest is best explored on foot.
- An umbrella or raincoat, as hot summer weather can bring occasional showers.

Currency and Payments Currency:

The official currency of Hungary is the Hungarian Forint (HUF). While many places accept credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, etc.), it is recommended to have cash for smaller purchases, especially in markets or more traditional establishments. Currency Exchange: Currency exchange services are available at the airport, major hotels, and exchange offices throughout the city. Keep in mind that exchange rates at the airport may not be the most favorable. ATMs are widely available, and many international debit/credit cards are accepted.

Tip: Tipping is customary in Hungary, typically around **10-15% in restaurants** if service is not included in the bill.

Must-See Attractions

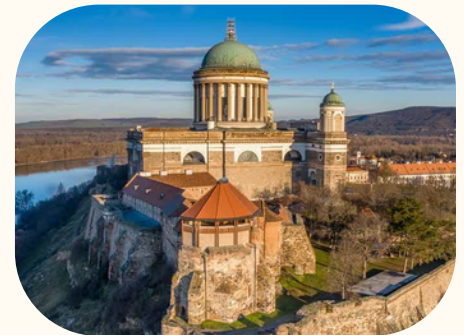
2. Visegrád:
